# **Public Hearings in December**

At the Wallace Town Council meeting in November, Council members received an update on various ongoing and planned projects for the airport from Airport Manager Ben Jones. Many of the projects are contingent on the road relocation, which is anticipated to start sometime in early 2024.

A request for voluntary annexation was on the agenda as well. The parcel for consideration is 158 acres situated to the south of Wallace, positioned between Rockfish Creek and Interstate 40 in Pender County. The Town Clerk is tasked with investigating the sufficiency of the annexation request. A public hearing has been slated for December 14 to address this matter.

Additionally, Rod Fritz, the Planning Director, shared the planning board's proposal concerning modifications to the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). These changes pertain to imposing restrictions on the permissible locations for tobacco/vape shops within the town's boundaries. The planning board recommends prohibiting such establishments from locating within 1,000 feet of schools, parks, greenways, residences, or similar retail outlets. Fritz suggested setting a public hearing to receive public comment on the proposed changes. This hearing is also scheduled for December 14.
